Saint Marguerite d'Youville

Saint Marguerite d'Youville was born in Varennes, Quebec, on October 15, 1701. She attended the Ursuline Convent in Quebec until 1714. In 1722, she married Francois You de la Decouverte in Notre Dame Catholic Church, Montreal. In 1727, she joined the confraternity of the Holy Family and her devotion to the Eternal Father became the focal point of her life. Tragically, her husband died on July 4, 1730, at thirty years of age, leaving her with two sons, Francois and Charles (who later became priests).

On December 31, 1737, Marguerite and several friends, who had been helping care for the poor and needy in their homes, consecrated themselves unreservedly to God for the rest of their lives, to serve the poor. This was the beginning of the Sisters of Charity, later to be known as the Grey Sisters.

In 1747, Marguerite accepted the administration of the dilapidated Hospital General des Freres Charon. Through industry, creativity and charity, she raised up the declining institution and improved the quality of care. Marguerite suffered the ordeals of war, famine, fire and personal health challenges, but nothing could discourage her. Her confidence in God the Father was steadfast. She died on December 23, 1771. To this day, St. Marguerite d'Youville manifests tenderness to those who pray with confidence.

Marguerite d'Youville is the first Canadian born person to become a Saint. In naming our school after her, the long service of the Grey Sisters in Whitby is also recognized.

School Operations

Emergency Contact Forms

A Student Information Form is sent home with every student in early September each school year. A parent/guardian is asked to update the information and return the form immediately. Should information change during the school year, please notify the office and your child's records will be updated.

Supervision of Students

Supervision on the yard begins at 8:15 a.m. After school the bus zone is supervised until approximately 3:15 p.m. There is no formal yard supervision after 3:15 p.m. as those students who walk to school are expected to leave for home immediately after dismissal.

Parking and Kiss & Ride

The parking lot on the west side of the property is our visitor parking. The south parking lot is designated for staff parking.

For the "Kiss and Ride" program vehicles are to enter the parking lot from the south entrance and drive between the island and the school to pick-up/drop off students. For after school pick up, vehicles will leave the parking lot or driveway AFTER our buses have left the driveway. If after buses have left your child is not in your vehicle we ask that you drive out the parking lot and around again to avoid blocking other vehicles.

Inclement Weather Conditions

If weather conditions force the cancellation of transportation services or classes, notification will be given by all local radio stations. Please note that when only the transportation has been cancelled, the school will remain open and classes will proceed. Please check the local radio stations (KX96, CKDO 1350, CFRB 1010, CHUM 1050 or 680 News). Cancellation information will also be posted on the Board's website at www.dcdsb.ca.

Breakfast Program

Beginning at 8:15 a.m. interested students are welcome to enjoy a nutritious breakfast as they arrive at school. Parent volunteers and staff prepare and supervise the program to 8:30 am.

Lunch Procedures

Students who stay at school for lunch are expected to observe the following guidelines, which have been established and clearly explained to them. Staff members and lunch hour supervisors supervise them during the lunch hour.

New for 2016-17 regarding leaving the school property during lunch. Primary and Junior students (grades K-6) are not permitted to leave the school property unless signed out and accompanied by a parent/guardian. Intermediate students (grades 7-8) are permitted to leave the school property if they have a written, dated and signed permission

note from their parent/guardian. <u>No food or</u> <u>drink is to be brought back to the school</u> by the grade 7/8 students. Food and drinks are not permitted in the yard due to student safety.

<u>Students who take the bus are not permitted to</u> <u>leave school property to go to the store at the</u> <u>end of the school day.</u>

In our attempt to reduce the amount of garbage we generate at the school, we would encourage all students to bring a "garbage-less" lunch to school daily.
